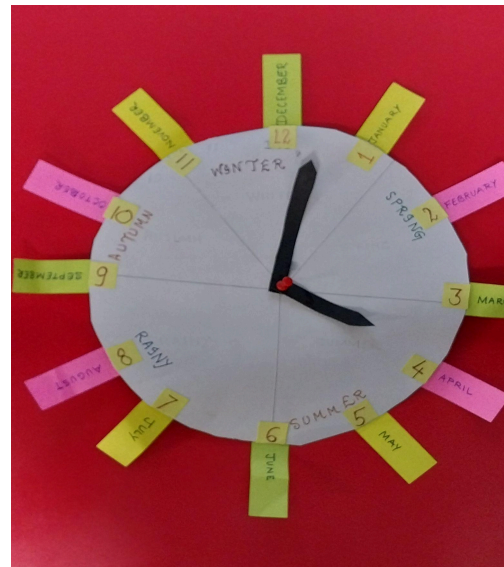
Label each section with the months that fall under that season.
