

How did it make you feel? Did anyone at home appreciate your effort?

2. A Letter of Love and Gratitude :

Parents and grandparents are true blessings, whose love for us knows no limits. This father's day write a gratitude letter to your grandfather/ father/uncle. You can include : Why you love him, thank him for something, some special memory, one quality of his that you admire. Prepare one eco-friendly band to gift him with your letter. **Click a picture with your grandfather/ father/ uncle while doing the activity.**

3. A Glass Full of Goodness:

Prepare a simple and healthy **summer drink** at home using natural ingredients like fruits, lemon, mint, cucumber, coconut water, etc. Decorate your drink creatively (use colorful straws, mint leaves, fruit slices, etc). **Click a clear picture of your prepared drink and paste it in your scrapbook.** **Information to Mention:** Name of your drink, Ingredients used, Nutritional benefits of the drink, What you enjoyed most while preparing it.

4. Fun with Weaving:

- Take a piece of cardboard and **cut small slits** (about 1 cm apart) on the top and bottom edges.
 - Tape one end of the wool to the back of the cardboard.
 - Pull the wool through the slits, moving up and down, to make the base (this is called the **warp**).
 - Now, take another piece of coloured wool and **start weaving** across — over one strand, under the next — and repeat. (this is called the **weft**)
 - Change colors to make your weaving **bright and colorful**.
 - Push the woven wool tightly together after each row.
 - Once you finish weaving, **tie off the loose ends** and secure them at the back with tape or glue.
- Paste the woven fabric in your scrapbook. Write 4–5 lines about what you made and what you enjoyed most while weaving. You can watch the given you tube link to get ideas for your project :
